



## Ski Racing Australia 2009-2010

Dear Member,

Welcome to another season of Motor Sports greatest kept secret.....Ski Racing. Please, whether you are rejoining or this is your first time, ALL READ this page. It contains important information that you should be aware of.

### Late Memberships

1. If you have not joined SRA a minimum of one week prior to your first event, then you will not be allowed to compete in that event. Three weeks prior to an event is required if a GPS setup is needed.

### Ambulance Cover

2. All Members should have appropriate (Australia Wide) ambulance cover. It has been deleted from our PA Insurance cover and you will be responsible for the payment if you are not covered.

### First Aid

3. All competitors (those over 13 years of age) are to complete an online first aid test via the SRA website [www.skiracing.com.au](http://www.skiracing.com.au) Every four years all competitors are to complete a practical CPR course.

### Fuel

4. Only Unleaded Commercially available fuel is allowed. Please refer to the current SRA rule book for specific information (rule 9.14)

### Rules

5. The current SRA rule book is available from the SRA website, please ensure that you are conversant with all the rules. Note new rule: All Boat Owners must have a current rule book in hard copy with them at all events.

### Sealing

6. All motors must be sealed prior to racing. (Exception MOC, Unlimited inboard & outboard and 60 and 70 MPH. BUT 60MPH & 70MPH will have to be sealed if entered in any other engine class.)

### Insurance

7. Boat insurance will not be transferred to any other boat unless new boat has the same owner. Boat insurance can be sold with a boat to new owner, providing SRA is informed and a copy of receipt of sale with new waterways registration details are supplied to SRA.

### Superclass

8. There are certain provisions for this class. Please get in touch with SRA before you commit yourself to a super class entry. You must meet the criteria set down and available from the SRA office. You must submit your team for SRA approval no later than August 15th 2009.
