## How to get here...

Lyme Regis is located in Dorset on the South West coast of England.

To get here by road

**Routes from North**

M5, A37, A3066, A30, A358, A35 & B3156

**Routes from East**

A30, A354, A338, A303, A31 & A35

**Routes from West**

A30, A35 & A3052

Follow signs to the 'Cobb'.

People towing boats will be met and shown where to park by the parking staff.

**CAUTION!** For those of you in large campers and towing boats, **AVOID** the Town Centre when you approach Lyme Regis. This area cannot accommodate large vehicles and you will get **STUCK**, it is also the wrong end of town!

**DO NOT RELY ON SAT NAV ONCE YOU ARRIVE IN LYME REGIS, IT WILL TAKE YOU INTO THE TOWN CENTRE - IT HAS BEEN TESTED!**



# Camping / Parking

The Lyme Regis Powerboat Club has allocated a designated camping area for competitors.

**There are 20 camping spaces available.**

The fee for the weekend is £45 per space.

The camping area will be available from -

**7 pm Friday 27th May until 6 pm Monday 30th May 2011.**

All camping spaces must be booked in advance. Please pay on arrival - **cash only**.

Spaces are available on a first come, first served basis.

To book a camping space, please provide:

1. Your name
2. Length of camping vehicle
3. Camping vehicle registration
4. Day of arrival

There are limited spaces (20) so please book early to avoid disappointment.

You will be issued with a camping pass which is to be displayed in your front window at all times.

You will be shown to a parking space by a member of the LRPBC on arrival, you CANNOT choose your own space - please respect the decision of the parking attendant.

## **NO CARS ARE ALLOWED IN THE CAMPING AREA.**

If you have a caravan your car must be parked in the Pay & Display car park.

No unauthorised vehicles are permitted to park in the LRPBC private car park.

If you are planning to arrive on the day and want to park on the seafront, PLEASE arrive early because the car parks can fill up by 10am, especially if the weather is good!

**7 pm Friday 27th May through to 6 pm Monday 30th May.**

Please **do not** arrive before this time, as you will be unable to park in this area - Lyme Regis has very strict campervan parking regulations.

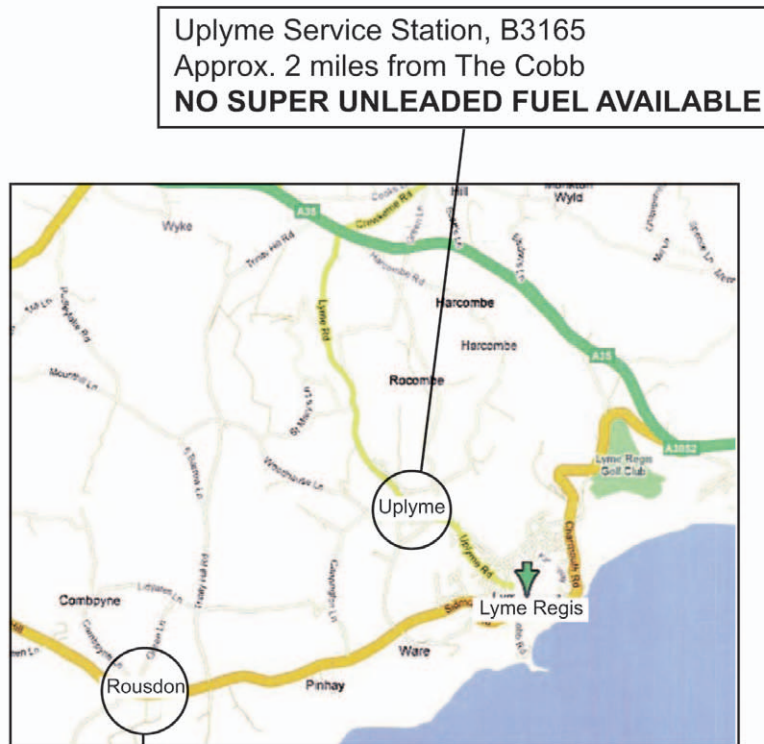
Boats will be taken to a secure compound at the top of the slipway on arrival.



# Places to fuel

We advise all boats arrive at the venue pre-fuelled if possible. Boats needing to refuel between races will have to come out of the water into a designated fuelling area.

The nearest fuelling stations have been outlined on the map below.



Uplyme Service Station, B3165  
Approx. 2 miles from The Cobb  
**NO SUPER UNLEADED FUEL AVAILABLE**

Rousdon Service Station, A3052  
Approx. 6 miles from The Cobb towards Sidmouth
